1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release his passport, which was seized by the Immigration Officer on 29.02.2024 at Amritsar International Airport.
2. Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the petitioner was called upon to furnish documents, which were furnished only on 16.10.2024 and she has instructions to state that petitioner’s case shall be considered within one week from today.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid statement, the writ petition is disposed of with observation that if the petitioner’s request is rejected, the competent authority shall pass a speaking order, which shall be communicated to the petitioner within one week from the date of passing of the order.
