SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners shall be satisfied if they are allowed to file reply to the impugned notice dated 30.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) and respondent No.2 – University is directed to decide the same. It is further requested that since the impugned notice dated 30.10.2024 is founded upon the policy decision taken by the Government of Punjab dated 06.03.2023 (Annexure P-2), the petitioners be permitted to make a representation to the State and direction be also issued to the State to decide the same.



2. In view of the above, this Court, without commenting upon merits, disposes of this petition with following directions :

- (i) If reply to notice dated 30.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) issued by respondent No.2 – University is filed by the petitioners within a period of ten days, same shall be decided by the University on its own merits without being influenced by the fact of the petitioners having approached this Court; and
- (ii) If a representation is made by the petitioners against notification dated 06.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Government of Punjab, same shall be decided by respondent No.1.

3. The aforesaid decisions be taken within a period of ten days from the date of submitting reply/representation to each of the authority, by passing speaking order and communicating the same to the petitioners.
