The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.791 dated 09.10.2023 under Sections 21 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Hansi, City.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.12.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The reply dated 03.02.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 08.12.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 08.12.2023 is made absolute.

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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
