1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to make the balance payment of Rs.1,03,28,050/- including security qua the works executed by the petitioner, alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted various representation(s) dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-3 Colly..) but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said representation(s).
3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and Ms. Gurneet Sagoo, Advocate, enters appearance (through V.C.) and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 3. They both pray for some time to complete the instructions and file response, if necessary.



5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3-The Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Barnala, is directed to consider and decide the representation(s) dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-3 Colly..) sent by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

6. Learned Counsel for respondent No.3 has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3-The Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Barnala to consider and decide the representation(s) dated 14.08.2024 (Annexure P-3 Colly..) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation(s), if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.

9. In the event of non-payment of dues within the said period, the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% per annum to be paid to the petitioner and subject to additional payment of a cost of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund (PPWF) of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh. The said additional



financial liability of accrued interest and cost shall be subject to recovery from the erring official.

10. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
