Through the instant revision petition, the petitioner has assailed the order dated 08.11.2019, whereby, the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak, has allowed the petition, as filed by the respondent under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C., and, has directed the petitioner to pay Rs.4,000/- per month, as maintenance, to the respondent.
