1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in FIR No.143 dated 07.11.2023, registered under Sections 454, 380 and 427 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.
