1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are eligible but promotions are not being made despite the fact that class III posts are available for promotion of the petitioners hence, respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners against the vacant posts.
2. Notice of motion.
3. Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as and when Government decides to make promotions to the Group C and D posts and in case the petitioners cleared the type test, the claim of all eligible persons

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including the petitioners on the basis of seniority will be considered and in case, the petitioners are found eligible and suitable for promotion, they will be granted the said benefit.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that as the petitioners have already passed the type test, they will not be subjected to the same but the others, who might be senior to the petitioners, will be given a chance to clear before effecting the promotion so that seniors are not prejudice in any manner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
