1. Status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Hisar has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record.
2. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.695 dated 19.11.2023, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the interim order dated 08.12.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further undertakes that he shall give his specimen handwriting as well as signatures before the concerned Area Magistrate. He further stated that the petitioner shall also handover the original copy of Will dated 12.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) to the Investigating

Officer of the present case, within a period of 10 days from today against receipt.

4. Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for respondent No.2 have vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, however, the learned State counsel has admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

5. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 08.12.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
