AMARJOT BHATTI J.

1. Petitioners Sunny, Kapoor Singh and Mahendri Devi have filed instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.126 dated 15.06.2020 under Sections 147, 149, 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings on the basis of compromise deed (Annexure P-2).

2. Facts of the case are that Sombir gave his statement that on 15.06.2020 he along with his niece came to Women Police Station in connection with dowry case filed by his niece against her in-laws. While both the parties were sitting in Police Station, Anil picked up a brick and gave brickbat blow on him and his brother Sanjay. Devender and Sunny gave kick blow to them. Kapoor, Namberdar and his wife Mahendri and daughter Sarita also gave fists blows and kicked them. Many people gathered there who intervened and pacified the matter. With these

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allegations, present FIR has been registered.

2. Petitioners have filed this petition for quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. Petitioners and respondent Nos.2 and 3 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. Detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate Jhajjar dated 11.06.2024. Statements of respondent Nos.2 and 3 have been recorded, where they confirmed the compromise with petitioners. They confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion from any side and they have no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

3. Petitioners also confirmed this fact in their separate statements. Statement of HC Sandeep is also recorded who stated that accused have not been declared as proclaimed offender.

4. Therefore, from the report of Chief Judicial Magistrate Jhajjar, it is clear that compromise has been effected between parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties. Present occurrence has background of matrimonial dispute. Now they have resolved their differences. They will be able to live in peace and harmony. It will end litigation started between them. No purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

5. Therefore considering these facts, petition filed by petitioners is accepted and FIR No.126 dated 15.06.2020 under Sections 147, 149, 323 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua them are quashed.

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6. Accordingly, present petition stands accepted.
7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
