1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS 2023 seeking setting aside of order dated 13.09.2024 Annexure P-2 passed by the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalalabad, District Fazilka, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in criminal complaint No.NACT-153/2020 titled Mukhtiar Singh Vs. Mohit Soni, under Section 138 of NI Act.

2. The counsel for the petitioner while restricting his arguments has submitted that the offence under Section 138 NI Act is a bailable offence and that petitioner is ready to surrender and apply for regular bail which be disposed of in a time bound manner by the Court concerned.

3. In light of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within next two weeks and

in case, he moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same is to be decided preferably within two days thereof in accordance with law and the trial Court may take lenient view in the light of the fact that the offence under Section 138 NI Act is a bailable offence.

4. Disposed of in aforesaid terms.
