This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction to the respondents No. 1 to 3 for safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners in the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10.

Learned counsel for the State submits that both the petitioners as well as respondents No. 4 to 10 have got their statements recorded when they were called for interrogation/enquiry after receipt of the representation dated 13.11.2024 which was submitted to the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.

In view of the statements recorded particularly by the petitioners indicate that they do not have any threat perception and they do not want to pursue any action against private respondents.

In view of the statement made by State Counsel in Court today, counsel for the petitioner do not wish to press the instant petition
