This is a contempt petition filed with Article 215 of the Constitution of India and under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 17.04.2023 passed in CWP-7744-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of order dated 12.12.2023, vide which, claim of the petitioner has been rejected. Copy of said order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if he feels aggrieved of the order passed by the respondents.
