VIKAS BAHL, J (ORAL)

1. This is a civil revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 18.10.2024, passed by the learned Appellate Authority, Ludhiana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the impugned order, observations have been made in favour of the petitioner including the fact that in case the present petitioner is able to show subsequent events with regard to the shifting of the respondent-landlord along with his daughter abroad, then the Appellate Court would take into consideration the said fact and has submitted that in view of the said observations, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to file an application under Order 41 Rule 27 CPC.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present civil revision petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
4. It is made clear that in case any such application is filed by the petitioner, the same would be considered independently, in accordance with law.
