1. Present petition has been preferred under Section 482 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.283 dated
07.09.2024 under Section 140(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for
short 'BNS') (Sections 64, 74, 3(5) of BNS and Sections 4 & 8 of the
Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 were added later on),
registered at Police Station Sector 13/17, Panipat, District Panipat.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present
petition and seeks liberty to file an anticipatory bail application before the

Court of Sessions at Panipat at the first instance. Learned counsel prays that he may be allowed to appear through video conferencing, as the petitioner is resident of Amritsar and his widowed mother is not in a position to travel to Panipat to engage a lawyer.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

4. In case the petitioner files an application seeking anticipatory bail within a period of one week from today, learned Sessions Judge, Panipat is directed to hear the arguments through video conferencing and decide the same, in accordance with law.
