[2] As per the aforesaid compliance affidavit, the benefit of
regularization has been accorded in favour of the petitioners, while stating
that financial benefits shall be released to them on or before 23.12.2024.

[3] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does
not press the present petition any further.

[4] Dismissed as not pressed.

[5] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs. 50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[6] Rule stands discharged.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
