**SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE ( Oral )**

1. The petitioner, who has no criminal antecedents and is in custody since 12.02.2024 for the offence of snatching, has filed this petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 12 dated 12.02.2024 under Sections 379-B and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Hathur, Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana, arising out of an incident, where a mobile and cash amount of Rs. 1,100/- were snatched by the petitioner.

2. Considering the fact that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents and trial will take long time to conclude, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties, in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to the condition that he shall plant 10 saplings of indigenous plants at a public place and submit proof in that regard by way



of photographs before the trial court within a period of 15 days and if there is no such intimation submitted or intimation is found to be incorrect, then the State can move an application for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

3. The petition stands allowed.
