1. This is the second petition filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

2. Upon instructions received from ASI, Baljinder Singh, State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order dated 13.12.2023 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that the petitioners are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. Interim order passed by this Court in connected petition bearing CRM-M-62110-2023 has been made absolute by an order passed on even date.
