2. Upon instructions received from ASI, Baljinder Singh, State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order dated 11.12.2023 passed by this Court, petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined and cooperated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that both the petitioners are no longer required for custodial interrogation.
