1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 04.09.2023 passed in CWP-19552-2023.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent has produced copy of speaking order, vide which, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and necessary amount qua the bills submitted by the petitioner has already been paid. No unpaid bill is left with the respondent. Copy of said speaking order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
