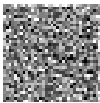

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent authorities to treat the services of Joginder Singh since deceased as deemed regularized/confirmed with a further prayer to direct the respondent authorities to release the benefit of financial assistance as per Rules and further to release the service benefits and pension/family pension to the petitioners with all consequential benefits and arrears thereof, alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners had served a legal notice dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) to respondents No.2 to 4 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the aforesaid



legal notice dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) is considered and decided by respondents No.2 to 4 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, she has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 13.08.2024 (Annexure P-10) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
