1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to the respondents to calculate their regular service which they have rendered during 2013 to 2018 with another Government Department i.e. Home Guards.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioners, at this stage, would be redressed if respondents are directed to decide representation dated 05.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner.
3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, assures the Court that representation dated 05.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioners would be disposed of in accordance with law within 3 months from today.
4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
