1. The present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.111 dated 02.06.2019 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.
2. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate, which is taken on record. At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the all the witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is a habitual offender, more so the quantity recovered from the petitioner was commercial.
3. Considering the fact that commercial quantity is involved and the petitioner has been convicted in another case, I do not find it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail.
4. Dismissed.
