1. Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.PC, seeking quashing of the FIR (Annexure P-1), and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 21.11.2023 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties. Details of the FIR are as under: -

[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 21.11.2023 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties.

[3]. Learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division)-cum-SDJM, Samrala, vide report dated 21.12.2023, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[4]. Respondent No. 2 is represented by her counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

[5]. In view of the aforesaid report of learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division)-cum-SDJM, Samrala, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since respondent No. 2 has herself compromised the dispute with the petitioner.

[6]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 201 dated 22.09.2023, under Sections 427, 452, 323 and 324 IPC registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana, (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioner.
