1. The petitioner is seeking setting aside of order dated 01.09.2023 (Annexure P-18) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Zira, District Ferozepur vide which his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and non-bailable warrants of arrest were issued against him in case FIR No.44 dated 01.07.2019 under Sections 379 and 411 of the IPC registered at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the

petitioner.

4. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
