The petitioner has approached this Court for seeking directions to respondent No. 4 to re-conduct the Speed Skating Races for 38th Haryana State Roller Skating Championship-2024 (Speed).

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the Rules notified for the said Skating Races were not in conformity with the Rules notified by the Roller Skating Federation of India dated 01.04.2023.

On being confronted as to how the writ petition is maintainable especially when the petitioner had participated in the championship tournament without challenging the Rules/norms notified for 38th Haryana State Roller Skating Championship-2024 (Speed) and as to whether a challenge would be maintainable at this juncture, once the petitioner voluntarily opted to participate in the event and the results are not to his liking. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to refer to any law to support his arguments.



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In view of the above, the present petition is **dismissed** at this stage, since there would a deemed acquiescence and waiver once a person has participated in his sporting event after being fully aware of the procedure. It is also not a case of the petitioner that he has in any manner been discriminated against any other participating player as per the Rules notified for the aforesaid championship.
