The present Criminal Writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondent Nos. 2 & 3 so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

[2] It is averred that petitioner No.1-Kiranpal Kaur aged about 32 years and petitioner No.2-Harshdeep Singh aged about 20 years, are residing in “Live-in Relationship” against the wishes to parents of petitioner No. 1.

[3] Since last two consecutive dates, i.e. 19.12.2023 & 11.01.2024, no one appeared on behalf of petitioners. Today also, none come present on behalf of petitioners. Thus, it appears that they are not interested in pursuing the present petition perhaps no cause of action survives in their favour. As a result thereof, there is no option except to dispose off the present petition.

[4] **Disposed off** accordingly.

[5] However, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition by instituting appropriate application, in case any fresh cause so arise(s).
