1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari with a prayer to set aside the order dated 16.05.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-6) vide which appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed by respondent No.1.

2. On 12.12.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Inter alia contends that the petitioner is ready to take care of his mother-respondent no.3 and to settle the dispute with respondent no.3 and has further submitted that in order to show his bonafide, the petitioner is ready to pay the arrears at the rate of Rs.12,000/- per month as ordered by the authorities vide order dated 16.05.2023 upheld vide order dated 06.11.2023 but has prayed for three months time.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to prepare

a demand draft at the rate of Rs.12,000/- per month in the name of respondent no.3 from 16.05.2023 and bring the same on the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 18.03.2024.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition as the petitioner wants to settle the matter with respondent No.3 (mother)
4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
