1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for issuance of directions to respondent
No.3 to conduct free, fair and speedy investigation in complaint
No.2024/013723 dated 19.05.2024 moved by the petitioner, registered on
05.08.2024, at Women Police Station Sector 17, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1)
and further to direct respondents No.2 & 3 to take action against respondent
No.5, as he, in collusion with respondents No.6 to 9, is harassing the petitioner
and is threatening to implicate her in a false case and also to assign the
aforesaid complaint to another Investigating Officer.

2. Learned Addl. PP, U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Aman Singh, at the very outset, submits that the private respondents have been called four times in connection with the complaint made by the petitioner and till date, they have not appeared in response to the notices issued to them. Now again notices have been issued to them for 25.11.2024.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file an appropriate application before the jurisdictional Court for redressal of the grievance raised in the present petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
