1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No. 267 dated 06.11.2021 under Sections 406, 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.
2. The petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police vide order dated 08.01.2024 passed by this Court.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner joined investigation with the police. The counsel for the petitioner further submits that parties have already entered into compromise and compromise quashing is pending for 14.03.2024 having CRM-M-65208-2023.

4. The State counsel on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, Police Station Sadar Patiala has endorsed the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation and further the matter stands compromised between the parties.

5. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 08.01.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner is to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
