NAMIT KUMAR, J.

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to re-fix and revise the pay of the petitioner correctly as was wrongly fixed while implementing the 5th Pay Commission Report in the year 2006 whereas, it was required to be fixed at Rs.3450/- instead of Rs.2950/- and to give all consequential benefits in terms of arrears of difference of pay and correct payment of retiral dues with interest.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.1 – Chairman-cum-Managing Director, to consider and decide the representation dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Seema Mand, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that she has no objection if the present petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-10) submitted by the petitioners.
5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.1 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.
6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
