1. On 21.11.2024, this Court was pleased to pass the following
order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the construction on the ground floor and first floor of the house in question has already been done prior to the passing of the order of status quo and only the lantern of the second floor is to be done. It is further submitted that the petitioner would not raise any further construction other than laying down the lantern on the second floor and also would not claim any equity in the main suit.

Notice of motion be issued to respondent No.1 only for 09.12.2024.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve respondent No.1 through dasti process as well as through the counsel appearing before the trial Court.

2. Learned counsel for contesting respondent no.1 has submitted that the premises in question has been sealed by the Municipal Corporation, Gurugram and the said Municipal Corporation is not a party in the suit and in the present petition.
