1. The present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.147 dated 29.09.2023 under Section 18 (c) of the NDPS Act (Section 29-A of NDPS Act added later on), registered at Police Station Jakhal, District Fatehabad.
2. After vehemently arguing on the merits of the case and in the light of the reply already filed by the State, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition and submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender however his regular bail application be decided expeditiously.
3. In light of the above, the petitioner is directed to surrender within 10 days from today and in case he files any regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within 10 working days, on its own merits.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
