[1] Status report by way of affidavit dated 08.02.2024 of Shri Vijay Pal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter, Hisar, on behalf of respondent-State has already been received through Registry. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel opposite.

[2] On 12.12.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Robin Lohan, Advocate for the petitioner.

Petitioner Meena Begam, lady, aged about 33 years, through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.1103 dated 09.09.2022, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 3 of Haryana Protection of Interest of Depositors in Financial Establishment Act, 2013, registered at Police Station Sadar, Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case for the reason that she is the wife of main accused namely Shahnaz Khan. It is further submitted that not even a single penny has been transferred in the account of the petitioner and she has been arraigned as an accused to pressurize her husband. The petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ambika Sood, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service. Learned State counsel submits that earlier also, the petitioner was involved in a similar case wherein she is alleged to have duped many on the pretext of GNM examination and is facing trial. She seeks time to file reply/status report.

List on 14.02.2024.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would associate as and when called. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on furnishing personal bond and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C ”

[3] Today, learned State Counsel, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 12.12.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[4] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 12.12.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, she shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
