The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

2. Vide order dated 26.02.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel filed status report dated 03.04.2024. The same is taken on record. He further, on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 13.03.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
