This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 24.11.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-26394-2023.

Pursuant to previous order dated 15.01.2024, Court Commissioners have filed the report dated 27.01.2024. The same is taken on record. It is stated in the report that the status quo has already been restored by the respondents. To the same effect is the argument raised by counsel for the respondents.

Even, learned counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the fact that the status quo, as it existed on the date of passing of the order has since been restored.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any further.
