The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.147, dated 02.06.2023 (Annexure P-6), under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

This Court vide order dated 23.01.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 23.01.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 31.01.2024 and lastly on 11.04.2024, which indicates and suffice enough for this Court to infer that he is duly cooperating with the Investigating Agency.

However, at this stage, learned State counsel has informed the Court that subsequently on 11.04.2024 vide GD No.15, certain new Sections i.e. Sections 465, 468 and 471 IPC have been added in the instant FIR.

The petitioner would be at liberty to move afresh before the trial Court for the newly added Sections.

In case, an application for bail is moved by the petitioner before the learned trial Court, the same shall be considered on the same date and decided in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.01.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed off.
