1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 23.08.2023 passed in CWP-30301-2018.
2. Reply/compliance report by way of affidavit of Parshant Atkaan, Joint Director (Admn.), office of the Director, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Department, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 23.08.2023 passed in CWP-30301-2018 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 06.05.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.



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5. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order dated 06.05.2024 passed by the concerned authority/respondent.

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1. Since the main petition has been finally disposed of, therefore, the present application has become infructuous.
