On 15.12.2023, following order was passed:

“The grievance of the petitioner is that FIR No.167 dated 01.07.2022 under Sections 120-B, 167, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC was registered at his instance at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamunanagar, copy of which is Annexure P.1. Despite lapse of more than 01 year and 05 months, no action is being taken by the Police and the culprits are not even being called for joining the investigation.

Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Copy of the petition be supplied to him during course of the day.

Learned State counsel further submits that investigation is going on at fair pace and in case, petitioner is any grievance, he can approach the Investigating Officer.
