itself.

Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to
respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners as their
lives is in danger due to threat given by respondent No.4 to 9 and further not to
harass the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 9 as the petitioners
having married against the wishes of parents of the relatives of petitioner No.1.

Petitioners alongwith their counsel are present in Court today.
Respondent No.5-Sonia and respondent No.6 Vikramjit Singh, are also present
in Court today.

The Court has interacted with the petitioners. Petitioner No.1 has
made number of insinuating comments regarding her family. She has submitted
before this Court that she is studying in B.Com final year and due to the conduct



of her family, she has now married with petitioner No.2 by her own will. She further submits that she is living a happy married life with petitioner No.2.

On the other hand, respondents No.5 and 6 (sister and brother-in-law of petitioner No.1) present in Court have submitted that they have no hesitation to accept the marriage/relationship of the petitioners, but mother of petitioner No.1 wants to talk to her and as such the present case may be adjourned to some short date.

In view of the above, when the private respondents have accepted the marriage of the petitioners and have not raised any objection to the same, no further order is required and the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail their remedy in case any further cause of action accrues to them, as per law.
