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The instant application has been moved for seeking pre-ponement of the date of the main case which is otherwise fixed for 27.01.2025.

Learned Counsel for the applicant-petitioner contends that the petitioner has an appointment for 'Police Clearance Certificate' fixed by the authorities for 31.12.2024 but the present petition filed by the petitioner is listed for 27.01.2025. He contends that the hearing in



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liberty to move an application with the respondent-authorities for issuance of a 'Police Clearance Certificate' and that an appropriate report, as per law, be submitted by the respondent-police officials on such an application preferred by the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondent-State of Punjab as well as Union of India have no objection to the same. The present application is accordingly allowed. The hearing in the main case is pre-poned from 27.01.2025 and the main case is taken up on Board today itself.

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The present writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to issue a 'Police Clearance Certificate' as well as clear the Police Verification Report of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to move a comprehensive representation to the respondent No.3 for granting of a 'Police Clearance Certificate' and that a decision in accordance with law be taken up on such a representation and the 'Police Clearance Certificate', in accordance with law, be issued to him in a time bound manner.

Counsel for the respondents has no objection to the same.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case with liberty to the petitioner to submit an application for issuance

In the event of submission of any such application, the same shall be processed expeditely and an appropriate decision shall be taken by the competent authority within a period of two weeks of submission of such an application.
