HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for respondents, on instructions, informs that financial benefits due towards the petitioners shall be released within a period of three weeks from today alongwith the calculation sheet.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for petitioners does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed.
- 4 However, in case, any claim of the petitioners still survives, they would be at liberty to raise their claim by filing representation before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from the release of payments, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter

from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioners within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to each of the petitioners from his / her own pocket.
