1. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Mr. Suhail Qasim Mir (IPS), SSP, Batala-respondent No.1, has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Inspector Prabhjot Singh, Police Station Qila Lal Singh, submits that the final report in terms of Section 193 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, shall be filed before the concerned Court within a period of two weeks from today.
3. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated

period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
