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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer herein is, inter alia, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No. 3, 5 and 6 to resolve the grouse of the petitioner by ensuring levelling of the street and proper drainage of the water, stalled in front of his house, as recognized by respondent No. 4 in the order dated 03.02.2023 (Annexure P-4).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of grievance of petitioner, he has served a legal notice dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) upon respondent No. 2 (Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Punjab), but the same has not been adverted to by concerned authorities, till date.

3. On advance service of copy of instant petition, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Learned State counsel submits that respondent No. 2 (Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Punjab)/competent authority shall take a decision either way, on the pending legal notice dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner, within a period of two months from today.

5. Learned counsel for petitioner, keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, submits that he does not intend to press the instant civil writ petition any further, at this stage.
6. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for parties, the instant civil writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending application (s), if any, shall also stand closed.
