This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6 claiming that he had moved a representation dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Inspector General of Police, Ludihana Range, Ludhiana, but no action on the said representation has been taken till date.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents.

3. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Seena Sandhu, Addl. AG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and, on instructions from HC Baljinder Singh, contends that the aforesaid representation is under consideration of the authorities and the Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Khanna, has



already summoned the petitioner twice for 21.11.2024 and 23.11.2024 but he did not appear for the purpose of inquiry, so as to settle his grievance.

4. In view of this fact, learned counsel for the petitioner has very fairly stated that the petitioner will appear on any date before the concerned authorities for the purpose of disposal of his representation and removal of his grievance.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has submitted that the petitioner may come to the office of Deputy Superintendent of Police (D), Khanna on 02.12.2024 at 11.A.M for this purpose.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner will approach the concerned authorities on 02.12.2024 at 11.AM.

7. In view of the aforesaid circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought withdrawal of the instant petition at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to file the same afresh, in case so required in future.

8. Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
