The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.106 dated 28.11.2023 registered under Sections 21(1) and 4(1) of Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957 at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 16.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
