1. On 15.12.2023, the following order was passed:

“The petitioner through the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No. 2 to re-issue his passport.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that correct date of birth of the petitioner is 20.12.2002, whereas in the passport, it has been recorded as 20.12.2003. The petitioner vide application dated 02.05.2023 has applied for re-issuance of passport with correct date of birth.

Notice of motion, returnable for 23.01.2024.

Learned counsel for Union of India, who on advance notice is present in Court, seeks time to get instructions.

2. Ms. Amrita Singh, Central Government Counsel for Union of India-respondents, submits that petitioner along with supporting documents may be directed to appear before competent authority who after considering case of the petitioner shall pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks thereafter.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid agreement.
4. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before respondent No.2 on 15.02.2024 at 10:00 AM along with requisite documents.
