1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for restraining the respondents from interfering into peaceful physical possession of the petitioners during the pendency of the Execution Revision No.201 with stay application dated 31.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) till the decision of the stay application.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to the petitioners to pursue their remedies before the concerned Court.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
