In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the husband of the petitioner was working with the respondents as Class-IV employee but after his death, the benefit admissible to the petitioner being the wife of the deceased employee have not been released.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once, the petitioner has been given the compassionate appointment, service benefit in respect of the service rendered by the late husband of the petitioner are also to be extended to her, which are being denied by the respondents with an ulterior motive.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner for the release of the service benefits in respect of the service rendered by her late husband will be considered and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and whatever the petitioner is held entitled for, the same will be released to her in case, there is no impediment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
