1. On 15.12.2023, the following order was passed:-

"Through the instant petition, a challenge is thrown to the declaration of both the petitioners as a proclaimed persons vide orders dated 18.4.2022 (Annexure P-1) and 7.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) respectively.

The foundation laid to challenge the orders (supra) is that the matter which arises out of money transaction, has now been settled between the parties, therefore, the success of the prosecution in the trial of the FIR No.8 dated 6.2.2020, under Section 420 IPC, registered in Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar, in which the petitioners have been declared as a proclaimed persons, is very less.

Mr. P.S.Grewal, DAG, Punjab, waives service on behalf of the respondent-State, whereas Ms. Kudrat Sareen, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and admit the factum of compromise between the parties.

Be that as it may, this Court do not find any illegality or perversity in the orders (supra) declaring the present petitioners as a proclaimed persons. However, they are directed to cause appearance before the learned trial Court concerned within 15 days from today. In case, the petitioners cause their appearance and file regular bail application, the learned trial Court concerned shall decide the bail application preferably on the same day, considering the above facts recorded by this Court. Till next 15 days, the arrest of the petitioners shall remain stayed."

2. In compliance to the directions issued by this Court on 15.12.2023, it is informed to this Court by learned counsel for the petitioners that both the petitioners have caused their appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, and have been released on regular bail.
3. Since both the petitioners have already caused their appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, and have been released on regular bail, therefore, no further action is required in the instant petition.
4. Disposed of accordingly.
