The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.216, dated 21.11.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Section 420 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the parties i.e. the petitioner as well as the respondent-complainant submit that the mediation proceedings could not succeed, as has been directed by this Court vide order dated 14.12.2023.

In the light of above, they submit that the present petition be heard on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an interim protection was granted to the petitioner by this Court vide aforesaid order with a direction to join the investigation.
